F. CTH Q (STH 19 – CTH K) 6.2 miles

G. CTHS (CTH A – STH 26) 1.4 miles

H. Design and Engineering for above

2. Timeline: 2022- Completion

## 3. Project Funding:

A. Allocate \$7 million of the allowed \$10 Million from the ARPA funds to the Dodge County Lost Public Sector Revenue Account (Per page #9 of the 1/2022 *Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds: Overview of Final Rule*).

These \$7 Million will be transferred to the Highway Department for the payments of costs for #1 above (Per page #11 of the 1/2022 *Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds: Overview of Final Rule*).

- B. Other Federal, State, County or Local funding that would become available.
