Questions & Answers

Question 1: Can the Pharmacy Services be bid on as a stand-alone service?

Answer: Dodge County is looking to secure an all-inclusive contract for the Health Care Services in the Dodge County Jail. It will be the responsibility of the selected Healthcare Provider to provide the Pharmacy Services.

Question 2: Are females housed within the jail? If so, how many?

Answer: In the first six months of 2023 our average population of females has been twenty-one.

Question 3: How often are intakes taking place?

Question 4: How many housing units are in the Pods?

Answer: Our dormitory pod (Pod H) and our indirect supervision pods (Pods A & B) have been designed and built with sections of housing areas within each.

Pod A has six sections to include two single person negative air flow cells and a two cell segregation section that has a safety cell.

Pod B has five section.

Pod H (the dormitory style Pod) has eight sections to include one two cell, segregation section.

Question 5: Can meds be kept on the person?

Answer: Generally no with exception of inhalers. No OTC is sold on commissary. Available OTC is provided during med pass in effort to control hording of OTC meds.

Question 6: What off-site hospitals are utilized?

Answer: *MMC Beaver Dam is nearest and used for Urgent Care and ER. Otherwise it depends on the situation and need.*

Question 7: Is an Electronic Medical Records (EMR) system currently being used?

Answer: Yes, records are currently kept electronically. Refer to the RFP for language describing this requirement in more detail.

Question 8: What is Huber?

Answer: In Wisconsin, Huber is the work release privilege that is part of a person's Judgment of Conviction and time served in a county jail.

Question 9: How many medication passes are allowed?

Answer: Currently our healthcare provider conducts two full med passes and other med passes as is necessary to administer meds.

Question 10: How often are sick calls being received?

Answer: Daily and dependent upon number and other workload. Sick Calls and 14 day physicals are a daily priority.

Question 11: How many AED's are within the facility?

Answer: One in each of the five housing areas, medical and intake. There is also an AED outside secure perimeter in the administrative office area.

Question 12: Is there an area for the Mental Health Provider?

Answer: Yes, there is an office location set-up for the Mental Health Provider. However, routine counseling does not take place in the medical area, but in the library/resource rooms located in each Pod (housing area).
