

Filing Instructions

- 1. As you complete the form:
 - Follow the instructions on the right side panel
 - Check for accuracy
 - Resolve any errors
- 2. Attach an electronic copy (jpeg, pdf, etc.) of your 2023 property tax bill
- 3. Click "Submit" when the form is complete
- 4. Before exiting, print and save a copy for your records (including your confirmation number)

• To apply for the 2023 credit: February 1, 2024 - October 1, 2024

You may claim this credit:

- For 2023 property taxes, payable in 2024, if on January 1, 2023, you were the owner of the property and used the property as your primary residence
- If you did not receive this credit on your 2023 property tax bill
- · If you have only one primary residence
- If you purchased the home after the January 1, 2023 certification date and the previous owner used the home as a primary residence on January 1, 2023

You cannot claim this credit:

- On business property, rental units, land, garages or other properties that are not your primary residence
- If the property was unoccupied on January 1, 2023
- . If you are not a Wisconsin resident
- If the property was neither your primary residence, nor the primary residence of the previous owner, on January 1, 2023
