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2 VEHICLE INJURY CRASH

On May 4, 2025, at 11:20 am, Dodge County Sheriff Deputies responded to a two-vehicle crash with injuries at the intersection of State Highway 33 at County Highway TW in the town of Hubbard, Dodge County, WI.

Through investigation, a 2021 Toyota Rav 4, was southbound on County Highway TW and was driven by a 33-year-old female from Sussex, WI. The driver stopped at the intersection but then pulled out in front of a westbound Ford F150 that was driven by a 46-year-old male from Plymouth, WI. The Toyota came to rest in the westbound lane of State Highway 33 and the Ford came to rest in the south ditch.

The driver of the Toyota received minor injuries and a 46-year-old male from Sussex, who was passenger in the Toyota, received possible serious but nonlife-threatening injury. The driver was transported to the Marshfield Medical Center in Beaver Dam and the male passenger was transported to Summit Hospital in Oconomowoc.

There were three passengers in the Ford F150 and all received minor injuries. The passengers were a 68-year-old male, a 20-year-old female, and a 17-year-old male. All are from Plymouth, WI. All were transported to Marshfield Medical Center in Beaver Dam.

State Highway 33 was detoured during the investigation and was closed for approximately one hour and forty-five minutes. Assisting at the scene were Horicon Police Department, Horicon Fire Department, Horicon EMS, Juneau Fire Department, Juneau EMS, Burnett Fire Department, Mayville Police Department, Mayville EMS, and Dodge County Emergency Response Team (DCERT).

This crash remains under investigation by the Dodge County Sheriff's Office Crash Investigation Team. Names are being withheld pending family notification.
