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SERIOUS INJURY MOTOR VEHICLE & FARM MACHINE CRASH

On May 9th, 2025, at approximately 8:53pm, Dodge County Sheriff's Office Deputies were dispatched to a passenger car versus tractor crash on State Road 33 east of County Road TW in the town of Hubbard, Dodge County, Wisconsin.

Initial investigation shows a 2011 Subaru passenger car was eastbound on State Road 33 when it collided with a 24-foot folded disk implement being towed by a Massey Ferguson tractor which was also traveling eastbound. The implement disconnected from the tractor and came to rest on the south side shoulder of the road. The tractor crossed the westbound lane of traffic before coming to a stop on the north shoulder of the road. The driver of the Subaru, a 19-year-old male from Iron Ridge was extricated from the vehicle. He was transported from the scene by Horicon Emergency Medical Services to the Marshfield Medical Clinic in Beaver Dam due to serious non-life-threatening injuries.

The operator of the Massey Ferguson tractor, a 64-year-old male from Hartford suffered minor injuries and was released at the scene.

Assisting at the scene were City of Horicon EMS, Village of Iron Ridge Fire and First Responders, Hustisford Fire, Neosho Fire and Lifestar Ambulance Service.

The names of the drivers are being withheld as the crash remains under investigation by the Dodge County Sheriff's Office.
