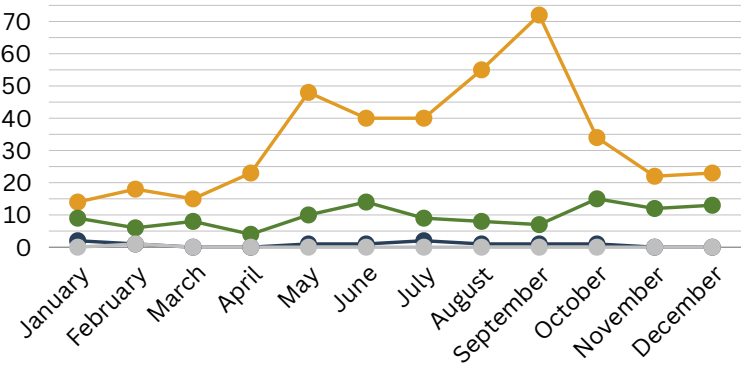

Election Administration

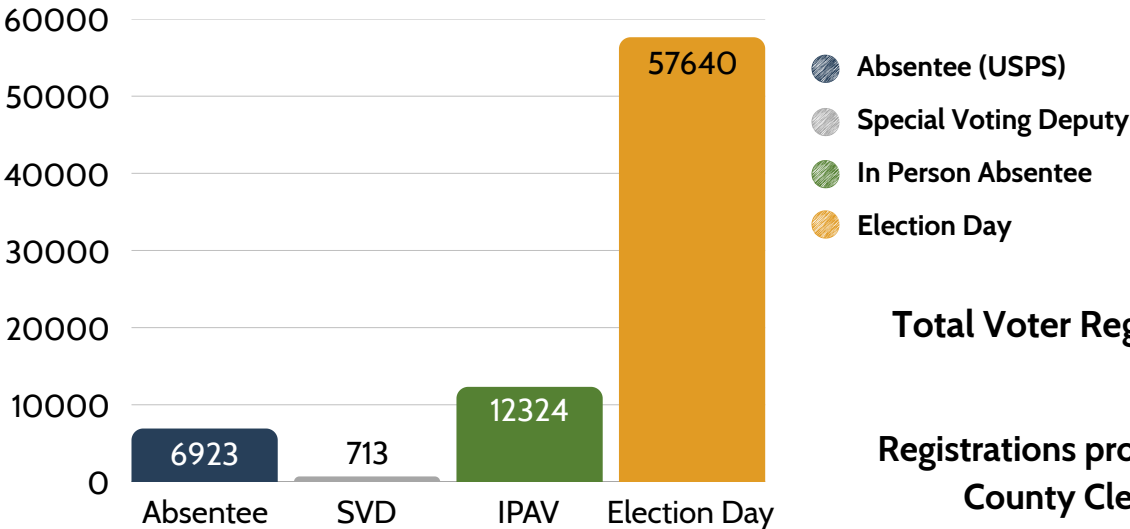
The County Clerk’s Office continues to provide WisVote services to municipalities in Dodge County. These services include:

Dog Licenses

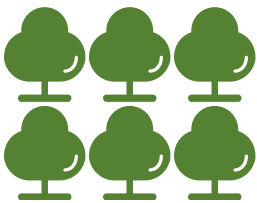

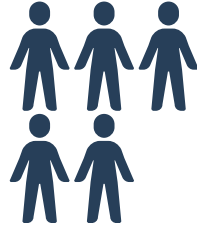
