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Serious Injury Motor Vehicle Crash

On Tuesday, May 27, 2025, at approximately 11:27 p.m., Dodge County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a report of a single motor vehicle crash on County Road MM near Bluebird Road in the township of Lebanon, Dodge County, Wisconsin.

Preliminary investigation showed that a 2017 Ram 1500 was traveling northbound on Bluebird Road, when it failed to stop at the stop sign, going through the intersection striking a tree and coming to rest in a small creek.

The driver and sole occupant of the 2017 Ram 1500, a 50-year-old male from Watertown Wisconsin was trapped in the vehicle and sustained serious, life-threatening injuries. He was extricated from the vehicle by fire personnel and transported from the scene by Flight for Life to Aurora Summit Hospital. The driver of the Ram was arrested for Operating While Impaired, first offense.

Assisting at the scene was Watertown EMS, Lebanon Fire Department, Lebanon First Responders, Flight for Life, and The Dodge County Crash Investigation Team.

This crash remains under investigation by the Dodge County Sheriff's Office.
